IOM Medical Certificate will be provided for all applicants (age 11 and over) who are free of infectious tuberculosis and who are applying for a visa to come to the United Kingdom for a period longer than six months.

IOM Working hours:

Monday – Friday, 08.00 – 17.00 Hrs. (Except Holidays observed by IOM) Medical examinations can be scheduled during these working hours, and will be carried out at one of two hospitals listed below:

Required Documents:

1. Original passport, and copy of the passport
2. Original passport or ID card and their copy for a parent or a legal guardian, accompanying children under 18 years old
3. Ante-Natal Care Book for pregnant women
4. Printed address in the UK

The fee is THB 3,800 (Three Thousand and Eight Hundred Thai Baht) per person Payment will be made at the IOM office, by cash, during registration and prior to the medical examination. Only spouses and children applying under the Family Reunion provision do not need to pay the fee at IOM. Those who believe they belong to this category should check with the UK Embassy.

Examination and Certificates:

Medical TB Detection procedure consists of:

- Registration at the IOM office from 9:00h – 12:00h and 13:00h – 15:00h by appointment
- Chest X-ray at one of the designated hospitals, after registration;
- Certificate issuing, at IOM office.

The certificate will be issued on same day if:

- The applicant completed medical examination during morning hours and returned to the IOM office with the results not later than at 15:00h and
- Chest X-ray findings do not warrant further examination.

The Certificate will be issued on the next day working day if:

- The applicant returned to the IOM office with the results later than at 15:00h and
- Chest X-ray findings do not warrant further examination.

In case of abnormal Chest X-ray findings additional diagnostic procedures may be needed. They may take up to four (4) working days after the initial examination. The applicants can only obtain their results in person at the IOM office.
